IV. Child Outcomes

- Laura Lindsey, ECE Coordinator, presented the child outcomes.
 - o The biggest increases were in literacy and math.
 - Three-year olds had the largest gain in cognitive and math.
 - o Four-year olds had the largest gain in literacy and math
 - Dual language learners had largest gain in literacy.
 - o Children with disabilities had a 25%-52% gain in literacy and math.
 - Three and four year olds did not meet two goals.
 - Program will conduct training to help change goals in grant. More is needed about arts.
